



## PPE REQUESTS BY COUNTY

### CLATSOP:

To request PPE supplies from Clatsop County Public Health contact Public Health at: [logistics@clatsopeoc.com](mailto:logistics@clatsopeoc.com) and let them know:

- Q) What is the name of the AFH Provider?
- Q) How many caregivers work currently? (Meaning they've worked at some point in the last week)
- Q) Do only some of your caregivers do actual direct contact with patient care?
- Q) What # of your caregivers do actual direct contact with personal care tasks, such as dressing, bathing, toileting, grooming?
- Q) Have any of your staff or residents been tested for COVID 19?
- Q) Have any of your staff or residents been quarantined at home for suspected, but not tested for COVID 19?
- Q) Have any of your staff or residents been tested with presumptive positive or confirmed COVID?
- Q) What amount of masks do you have available to use now?
- Q) What is your email, so we can coordinate any delivery, if there are any available for your AFH?
- Q) What is the best phone # to contact?

**With regard to requesting PPE, here is the current process:**

1. Check with your current vendor to allocate necessary supplies
2. If your vendor **cannot fulfill** your request, please reach out to your other partners for supplies
3. If your partners **cannot assist** in the provision of PPE to your organization, please contact me ([myattp@co.yamhill.or.us](mailto:myattp@co.yamhill.or.us))
4. Yamhill County Public Health will work with you using the following the guidance from OHA in acquiring the necessary PPE. We will ask you the following questions:
  - a. Are you a healthcare facility or provide direct patient care?
  - b. What is the status of personal protective equipment (PPE) in your facility or healthcare setting? (Insufficient PPE, depleting PPE with no order fulfillment, no immediate issue)
  - c. What type of PPE is in short supply?
  - d. What is the PPE needed for?
  - e. Can your vendor fulfill your PPE needs?
  - f. Have you attempted to order from other vendors?
  - g. Have you reached out to your partners the provision of PPE?
  - h. Has your organization implemented PPE supply optimization strategies?

**Note:** Currently, the provision of N-95s is being prioritized for healthcare providers who have **an urgent need** to meet clinical operations. As such, not all requests may be fulfilled.
